Week 2: Think Eternal

Bottom Line:

Don't just think temporary. Think eternal.

Message Overview:

As a high school or middle school student, TIME is the best commodity you have. And during the summer, you have lots of it. Fortunately, the Bible has a lot to say about what we do with our time. In week 2, we're going to talk about how to think eternal. Since our days on this earth are numbered, what you think about is very important. And every student has a choice – *think*.

Scripture References: Psalm 39:4-5, Ecclesiastes 3:11

Questions:

1. If you could choose, how many years would you like to live? Why this many?
2. Read Ecclesiastes 3:11 – What does that mean to you? How could you reword that into the way we would speak?
3. Is eternity something you think about often? Do you believe that everybody thinks about it at some point or another?
4. Why are your thoughts so important when it comes to what you do and who you are?
5. Can you think of some examples of how we live *-thinking about our lives now as opposed to thinking about life after this life?* (**SGL's – have some examples ready.**)
6. What would change about your life if you started thinking about life after this life?
 - a. What would change about your relationship with God?
 - b. What would change about your relationships with your friends?
 - c. What would change about how you think about serving?

The Next Step:

Encourage your students to... *Think!* This week, encourage them to start viewing life through an eternal lens. When deciding what to do with their summer days, challenge them to **THINK** about **ETERNITY!**
